## GETTING BEHIND THE LABEL

### WHITE GRAPES

#### *Sauvignon Blanc*

High acidity and juicy, light in body - defining traits of Sauvignon Blanc are citrus fruits, crisp, dry, refreshing. If you like that, then try Riesling, Picpoul, Vermentino, Verdejo (Rueda), Muscadet.

#### *Chardonnay*

Full-bodied dry wine and low in acidity - the primary flavours of Chardonnay include ripe golden, orchard fruits. If you like that, try Côtes du Rhône Blanc & Pinot Blanc. For oaked Chardonnay, traits are butter, cream, vanilla, toffee. If you like that, try Viognier, Godello, Pinot Gris & Chenin Blanc (oaked).

#### *Pinot Grigio*

Dry, light-bodied and high in acidity. The palate is refreshingly crisp with vibrant citrus flavours. If you like that, try Pinot Blanc or an un-oaked Chardonnay.

#### *Albariño*

Crisp and bright white wine. Albariño is rarely oaked, which allows you to taste the true flavors of the grape. It's citrusy, minerally, and has a good amount of acid, which can make it a fantastic food wine. If you like that, try Grüner Veltliner, Verdejo, un-oaked Chenin Blanc or Godello.



## RED GRAPES

### *Malbec*

High acidity, juicy and full-bodied - defining traits of Malbec are black fruits, with spice & vanilla in oaked wines. If you like that, then try Bordeaux, Cabernet Franc, Chianti Classico, Brunello. For un-oaked wines, try Mencia, Gamay or Beaujolais.

### *Cabernet Sauvignon*

Full-bodied with dark fruit flavours, the Cabernet grape variety gives high tannin and acidity levels. If you like that, then try Bordeaux, Merlot, Tannat, Cabernet Franc or Nero d'Avola.

### *Merlot*

Full-bodied with mild acidity, smooth tannins and dark fruit flavours. If you like that, try Primitivo, St Emilion, Montepulciano.

### *Syrah | Shiraz*

Full bodied, moderate tannins. Defining traits of Shiraz or Syrah are pepper, black & red fruits, spice. If you like that, try Côtes du Rhône, Crozes Hermitage, St Joseph, Garnacha.

### *Tempranillo (Rioja)*

Full bodied, soft tannins - defining traits of Tempranillo are ripe strawberries & black fruits. Lead variety in Rioja wines. If you like that, try Ribera del Duero, Toro, Portuguese reds.
